Child Molester Sentenced to Prison with No Parole September 16, 2016

Bryan, TX - Eddie Galvan, 42, was sentenced to 35years in prison yesterday after pleading guilty to Continuous Sexual Abuse of a Young Child. Because of the charge, Galvan will not be eligible for parole and will be required to serve the entire 35 years. Galvan was arrested on October 12, 2015, after a family member witnessed him behaving inappropriately with a young family member at a family gathering. After questioning the young girl, the family member determined that Galvan had touched her inappropriately as well.

Through the course of the investigation, the Bryan Police Department was able to identify several other young family members who disclosed that Galvan had also abused them on multiple occasions. Galvan was ultimately charged with two counts of Continuous Sexual Abuse in relation to the abuse of six different children. Galvan was previously sentenced to prison in 2004 for Burglary of a Habitation Assistant District Attorney Kara Comte prosecuted the case on behalf of the District Attorney's Office
