Man Gets 25 Years for Robbery in Parking Lot of Restaurant February 19, 2018

Bryan, TX – On Friday, February 16, 2018, 29-year-old Jeromy Lowery pled guilty and was sentenced to twenty-five years in prison for robbing a couple in a local restaurant's parking lot.

On March 26, 2017, Lowery hid behind a vehicle and watched the victim and her family exit the restaurant and get into their vehicle around 1pm. Once the family was inside the vehicle, Lowery snuck up, opened the front passenger door, grabbed a purse, and ran off.

The victim's husband then chased after Lowery, at which point Lowery turned and threated to assault him.

Lowery was apprehended after a short foot-chase across University Drive.

CSPD had a unit in the area and was on the scene almost immediately. Lowery also attempted to run from the police but was caught and arrested at the scene. Lowery was also sentenced to time for Evading Arrest.
